The Relgalf Scholarship is a three-year educational forgiveness loan created by the Relgalf Charitable Foundation to increase the resources of small police departments. The scholarship pays tuition and fees for an undergraduate degree in FSU's College of Criminology & Criminal Justice for current police officers with an AA degree. To receive this award, the recipient must be a sworn officer in a small police department for three years after graduation. If the recipient does not meet this requirement they must re-pay the award in full.
