

ONLINE UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

APPLICATION PROCESS:

How do I apply to FSU's online criminology program?

Every applicant needs to apply through the FSU Office of Admissions.

What are the admissions deadlines?

The online undergraduate degree admission deadlines are as follows:

- Fall-July 1
- Spring-Nov. 1
- Summer-March 1

What are the prerequisites for the online program?

Applicants must have completed their Associates of Arts (AA) degree in Florida, or have met all of the FSU Liberal Studies requirements.

ONLINE PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Is this a full-time program?

No, this is a part-time program. Our online program is designed for students who cannot attend regularly scheduled class sessions due to working a full-time job or having limited on-campus availability.

Will I have an advisor to guide me throughout the duration of my program?

Yes, every FSU student has an academic advisor within his or her designated college. Contact information for our undergraduate advisors is available on our website.

As a student in the online criminology program, will I be able to double major?

Yes, students can double major as long as their second major is also online. It is the student's responsibility to contact the designated department to inquire about the additional major.

Will I be able to complete a minor with my online criminology degree?

Yes, students can also complete a minor as long as their minor is also obtained online. It is the student's responsibility to contact the designated department to inquire about the minor. Please refer to the <u>list of minors</u> for more details.

TUITION INFORMATION:

What is the tuition rate for online courses?

The online tuition rate for courses is different than the campus tuition rates. Online courses include a technology fee and are therefore slightly more than campus courses.

Will the State Employee Tuition Waiver cover the cost of courses?

No, the State Employee Tuition Waiver will not cover the costs for the criminology undergraduate online program.

GRADUATION INFORMATION:

Will I be able to participate in the FSU commencement ceremony?

Yes, upon successful completion of the program, students are eligible to participate in the commencement ceremony. Contact the <u>Registrar's Graduation department</u> for more details.

What will my diploma look like?

Upon successful completion of our online program, students will be awarded the same diploma as main campus students.
